PURPOSE

This administrative procedure shall define what courses may be taken to meet the Health requirement for graduation.

PROCEDURE

1. In order to graduate from high school a student must earn one-half (.5) credit in Health. This requirement may be met in one of the following ways:
 - a. Earn one-half (.5) credit in Health.
 - b. Successfully complete any five semesters in an HSROTC program.
 - c. Successfully complete both semesters of one of any of the following courses:
 - i. 10513/10514 Health Science I
 - ii. 10515/10516 Health Science II
 - iii. 10533/10534 Emergency Medical Services
 - iv. 10885/10886 Human Development I
2. It should be noted that there is no language in regulation that provides for exceptions to the graduation requirements based on religious beliefs; therefore, there is no exemption available for the Health requirement because of religious beliefs.

1. This Administrative Procedure reflects the goals of the District's Strategic Plan.
2. This Administrative Procedure aligns with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 389, Examinations, Courses, Standards and Graduation.
