## **PURPOSE**

This Administrative Procedure shall establish the process to converting a College Board College Level Examination Program or CLEP Exam to high school credit.

## **DEFINITIONS**

1. "CLEP EXAM or College Level Examination Program" is an examination offered by the College Board that is similar to a credit by exam offered in high school where a student may earn college credit for a passing score of 50.

## **PROCEDURE**

1. Students can take CLEP exams through College Board on their own and present them to their high school registrar for credit.
  - a. The list of CLEP exams can be found at <https://clep.collegeboard.org/exams>.
2. CLEP exams with a score of 50 or higher will be posted to the transcript with:
  - a. The title of the CLEP exam;
  - b. A grade of S on the transcript;
  - c. A weighted bump of .025 (honors); and
  - d. 1.0 credit for the course in the subject area of the exam.
3. CLEP exams with a score of 49 or lower should not be presented to the school registrar. If presented, the CLEP exam will be posted to the transcript with:
  - a. The title of the CLEP exam;
  - b. A grade of U on the transcript;
  - c. No weighted bump; and
  - d. No credit for the course.
4. The CLEP exam is not part of the student's academic load.
5. Middle school students are not eligible to participate in CLEP exams for credit.

  - a. NRS Chapter 389, specifically: 389.171 Credit granted for performance on examination in lieu of course attendance; regulations.
  - b. NAC Chapter 389, specifically: 389.670 Credit granted for performance on examination in lieu of course attendance: Board of trustees required to prescribe application and eligible courses of study; effect of pupil’s

withdrawal from school; authority of State Board to review examination and minimum score required.
